Annual Author Luncheon – April 23

Barbara J. Taylor to speak at the Back Mountain Library Author Luncheon

The Friends of the Back Mountain Memorial Library will host their **32nd Annual Luncheon with a Special Author on Thursday, April 23rd at AppleTree Terrace, Newberry Estate, Dallas.** The guest speaker will be Barbara J. Taylor, an author who was born and raised in Scranton, Pennsylvania.

Barbara J. Taylor sets her novels in the hometown she loves and populates them with miners, evangelists, vaudevillians, gangsters, and a prostitute or two. *Publishers Weekly* named her first book, *Sing in the Morning, Cry at Night*, a "Best Book of Summer, 2014," and author Jay Parini called it, "A first-rate debut." Her second novel, *All Waiting Is Long*, received a starred review from *Booklist* and the American Library Association. Taylor is one of Kaylie Jones Books' and Akashic Books' bestselling authors.



Taylor attended the University of Scranton where she received a BA in English and an MS in education. She taught English in the Pocono Mountain School District for thirty-one years. In the latter part of her career, she returned to graduate school, this time at Wilkes University, and earned an MFA in creative writing. Taylor recently retired from Pocono Mountain to write full-time. She's currently at work on the last novel in her trilogy, tentatively titled, *Rain Breaks No Bones*.
